RECENT CLUB UPGRADES

There have been many upgrades to the Club to help improve our building and ice for our members this past off season!

The SCC received a \$23,200 Capital Grant from the Provincial Government's Ontario Trillium Foundation (OTF) that was used to complete damp proofing and drainage to the exterior of the Club. The project will ensure the Club does not experience any more flooding on the ice surface and can continue to provide reliable and quality curling programs for the community.

As some of you may know, our Club has a sand surface with the cooling pipes embedded in the sand. From year to year, as the ice is taken out, some of the sand is lost and must be replaced. Thanks to some help from some amazing members and board members, we were able to add and level more sand to the ice surface. Special thanks to Rob Scott, Brian Besley and Hunter Wilson for their hours of work to prepare for the "sand day". Thanks also to Jason Furlong for donating the use of his John Deere tractor to help transport the sand.
